**Flight Odyssey** responded to a NASA call for tenders to dismantle the facilities intended to rescue the American Space Shuttle in the event of a launch failure.

The Zaragoza airfield in Spain was one of the Shuttle's diversion field, and some equipment still remains there.

Thanks to our efficient cargo fleet, we are selected to repatriate these items. The purpose of the contract for which we have been selected is to transport them from Zaragoza, Spain, to Cologne, Germany, where they will then be centralized for shipment back to the USA. We will not be responsible for transport to the USA, only to Cologne.

The payload is expected to be around 61000 pounds.

Please note the attached **Technical Log Book** for this flight. The aircraft will unfortunately not be repaired before your flight, and you will have to take it as is!

Obviously, both flights must be operated on **the same day**, and with the same aircraft. Loading time in Zaragoza is expected to take between 1 and 2 hours, depending on the number of staff available on site. Please be patient!
